



Rental Homes

Because the rental homes were built with some government funds, renters must meet certain income guidelines set by government agencies. Rental rates change from time to time and leasing is handled by a property manager.

The sizes of the homes are:

Two-bedroom apartments 960 sq. ft.

Most one-bedroom apartments 760 sq. ft.

One-bedrooms in Common House 590 sq. ft.

Utilities:

Trash pickup is included in the rent, but utilities are not included. For a 1-bedroom home, electricity, water, and sewer would be about \$120 a month. However, there are many variables, depending on weather events, use of appliances, etc.


Affordability by Design

- Select a location where real estate and housing are less expensive
- Get an architect that has experience in designing less cost housing
- Look for an affordable housing developer
- Use public funds for construction which have lower interest rates
- Compare bank charges and rates for construction loans
- Use local banks if possible
- Select a housing authority or developer to develop, and a property manager to manage, the rental units
- Price housing for First Time Homebuyers




Affordability by Intention
