- is a registered national non-profit organization
- is a membership based organization (members are communities)
- was formed in 1992

43 member communities

- 14 are forming communities
- 5 are in development
- 4 are under construction
- 20 are completed

- One annual board meeting and AGM

Annual Budget

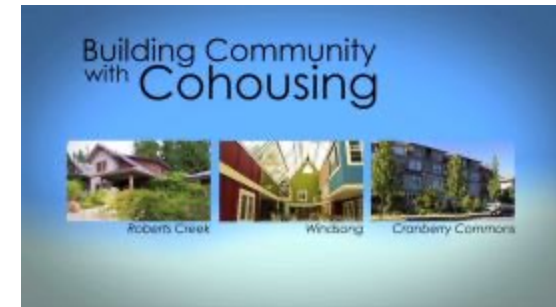
- \$10-12,000 / year
