Something happens when we witness the alignment of one's actions with their stated values. A shift occurs in our perception of the other, but also within ourselves. We are reminded that our values. when actualized, have power. We learn that it's possible to stand rooted in our beliefs, and we



are more likely to create this alignment in our own lives.

I experienced this shift in myself earlier this month when I learned that <u>Pioneer Valley Cohousing</u> in Amherst, MA would change their name to Cherry Hill Cohousing, eliminating a word that members feel is disrespectful to Indigenous peoples. This is an act of integrity; a moment when community members collectively decided to actualize their values. The majority of cohousing communities in the US have a set of community values. They serve as the pillars of our communities – how we relate to one another and to the world outside. How often do we revisit our collective values, and ensure that our actions are in alignment?

For many communities, how they choose to govern themselves reflects their values. <u>Sociocracy</u> is a governance model that prioritizes inclusion and efficiency. A growing number of cohousing communities are choosing to explore sociocracy as a model for decision-making and operations.
